Ethical Considerations: The Khepera Method Approach

Harmony: is the process of locating the fulcrum point to balance our desire for personal success and our desire to do something for the common good.

Wisdom: the ability to use both objective and intuitive modes of knowing in order to create meaning, and in order to analyze the various expressions in which meaning is manifested.

Power: the ability of the individual and/ or community to make change in a manner that demonstrates our interconnectedness.
